# Lacquer Italian formula (IF)

LAIF110 (glossy) / LAIF120 (1/2 matt) / LAIF130 (30% gloss) / LAIF140 (matt)

# **DESCRIPTION**

Extremely high quality of lacquer, produced upon an Italian formula, applied with 10% of hardener, not suitable for water immersion.

# **APPLICATION CHARACTERISTICS**

- High weathering, cracking, yellowing & abrasion resistance.
- Excellent gloss retention and durability .

## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **DILUTION & CLEANING-UP**

#### Dilution:

The recommended solvent is the thinner , that the percentage depend on the application viscosity:

Air – spray application: 25 – 35 %Brush/roller application: 10 – 15 %

## Cleaning - up:

Clean the hands and the tools immediately with thinner.

#### **APPLICATION**

- Apply on a dry, clean and at least primed surface .
- The temperature of the substrate should not fall down 10°C during the application.
- Mix well the lacquer with the desired percentage of thinner and 10% of hardener, directly before use, without exceeding the diluents quantity, otherwise the filling ability could decrease.
- The lacquer should be used as a top coat .

# **SAFETY & LIMITATIONS**

- Flammable: keep away from heat, direct sunlight and fire source.
- Toxic if swallowed: keep away from the reach of children.
- Toxic by vapor inhalation : avoid to apply this product in the presence of children and pregnant women .
- Irritating to eyes and skin: use eye protection glasses, face mask and gloves while applying; in case of eye contact, flush immediately with a large amount of water.

# **SHIPPING**

## **PACKING**

5L gallon - 25 L pails.

## **STORAGE**

Store in a dry, cool and ventilated place, in a closed container.
